

**Pattern**

Teddy Bears

**Task**

To make 2 identical teddy bears for baby's that pass away. Families are able to keep one teddy with the baby and keep an identical one in the keepsake box we provide.

**Sizes**

Any of the following sizes can be used as long as they are a matching set of 2.

*Small Teddy Bear*

3 ply 2.5 mm (14)

4ply 2.00 mm (12)

*Medium Teddy Bear*

4 ply 2.5mm (12)

*Large Teddy Bear*

Take 2 sts less on each leg and arm

5ply 3.25mm (10)



**Material**

Please make bears in soft pastel colors either white, pink, blue so that they can match with our blankets and matching pillow sets that are also put into the boxes.

**Construction**

Cast on 10 stitches and knit 20 rows-leave on needle.

Cast on another 10 stitches and knit 20 rows.

Knit 26 rows across 2 legs and then cast on 12 stitches in next 2 rows.

Knit 10 rows cast off 12 stitches at the beginning of next 2 rows and then knit 46 rows.

Cast on 12 stitches in next 2 rows, knit 10 rows, knit 10 rows.

Cast off 12 stitches at the beginning of next 2 rows.

Knit 26 rows then knit 20 rows on first next. 10 stitches and cast those off.

Join yarn to remaining 10 stitches, knit 20 rows on remaining 10 stitches, cast off.

Sew the front and back of the bear together and stuff firmly.

Sew across corner of head to form ears.

Embroider face and tie a bow around the bear's neck.
